CUNY Libraries use the **Library of Congress** classification system to organize materials. Items are arranged by the **SUBJECT** of the item.

How to read a Call #: PS 3515 .U789 Z63 2003

PS	Line 1
3515	Line 2
.U789	Line 3
.Z63	Line 4
2003	Line 5

- Line 1: Read in Alphabetical order
- Line 2: Read as a **WHOLE #**
- Line 3 and Line 4: Read as a combination of a letter & number.
Read letter alphabetical and then read the number as a **DECIMAL**
- Line 5: Read as a year
