RefWorks – style guide citation database

- Go to the City College Library homepage - <http://www.ccny.cuny.edu/library/>
- Click “Quick links to selected resources”
- Click “RefWorks” located under “Cite Sources”
- Create an account
- You can import bibliographic information from databases like EBSCOHOST into this database. RefWorks will create a bibliography of your articles which you can import into your word processor.

**HOW TO ACCESS DATABASES FROM OFF CAMPUS
(ONLY For City College ID Holders)**

Go to **City College Library** homepage: <http://www1.cuny.cuny.edu/library/services.cfm>

- 1) Click “**Quick Links to Selected Resources**” – At bottom of page
- 2) Click on the database you wish to access
- 3) **RETURN USERS:** Sign in with email and password you created.
- 4) **FIRST TIME USERS:** Type in your 14-digit CCNY ID barcode.
 - a. You now create email logon and password.
 - b. Then sign in as a “Return User”
- 5) **FORGOT PASSWORD:** Type in your 14-digit CCNY ID barcode.
